



Please sort **Recyclables** into the following **8 categories**. For **Glass Containers (Bin)**, there are **2 additional categories**, and for **Paper Garbage**, there are **5 additional categories**.

Look for This Mark

Plastic Containers

Plastic Containers and Packaging

If the Plastic Containers/Packaging are dirty and you are unable to clean them, please sort them into Burnable Garbage.

Can

Cans

PET

PET Bottles

Empty Out All of the Contents

Remove labels. Remove lids (caps). PET Bottle labels/lids should be sorted with "Plastic Containers and Packaging."

Bin

Glass Containers (Bin)

Separate the Glass Containers into 2 Categories. The metal lids of energy/vitamin drinks should be sorted with "Non-Burnable Garbage."

① Colorless (Transparent)

② Colored

Remove lids (caps).

White Trays Styrofoam

White Styrofoam Trays Styrofoam Packaging

If the White Styrofoam Trays/Styrofoam are dirty and you are unable to clean them, please sort them into Burnable Garbage.

If the Styrofoam cannot fit into garbage bags, please tie with a string.

Dry Batteries Fluorescent Tubes

※ You can also take Dry Batteries to the "Collection Box" at your nearest Community Center.

Clothing Fabric

Clothing Fabric

Underwears should be sorted with "Burnable."

Please take out Clothing and Fabric that have been washed and dried, not ones that are still dirty or soaked.

Paper

Paper Garbage

① Newspapers and Newspaper Inserts

② Cardboard

③ Drink Cartons

④ Books, Magazines

⑤ Other Types of Paper (Miscellaneous)

Sort Paper Garbage into these 5 categories and take them out.

Recyclables are divided into types. They should be placed into **separate Transparent or Semi-Transparent Bags** whose contents can be confirmed and taken to a Garbage Collection Location according to their type.

※ Use Transparent or Semi-Transparent Bags whose contents can be confirmed.
※ The volume limit for bags is 45L.

※ For Plastic Containers, White Styrofoam Trays, PET Bottles, Cans, and Glass Containers (Bin), please rinse them before taking them out.

※ Paper Garbage other than Other Types of Paper (Miscellaneous) should be tied together with a string and taken to a Garbage Collection Location. (Miscellaneous Paper Garbage should be placed in garbage bags)

Recyclables

- Designated Garbage Bags are sold at retail stores, etc.
- Recyclables and garbage that have not been sorted properly, are not in the proper bags, or whose contents cannot be confirmed will NOT be collected, so please follow the Garbage Rules.
- Garbage from Offices, Stores, etc., CANNOT be taken to a Garbage Collection Location.
- Designated Garbage Bags from before the Shima City Merger (before 2004) CANNOT be used. (Those from 2004 onwards CAN be used).

Non-Burnable

LED Fluorescent Tubes (Plastic)
Open up a hole in spray cans.

Glass Ceramics

LED Fluorescent Tubes (Glass) Glass/Ceramic Tableware, Vases, Plant Pots, Incandescent Light Bulbs, Glass, etc.

Non-Burnable Garbage

※ You CANNOT take these types of garbage to the Yamada Eco-Center.

Please place "Non-Burnable Garbage" and "Glass/Ceramics" in **separate, durable Transparent or Semi-Transparent Trash Bags**, and take them to a Garbage Collection Location.

※ The volume limit for bags is 45L.

Burnable

※ Please make sure to properly drain water from Food Waste

Burnable Garbage

Place Burnable Garbage in the Designated "Burnable Garbage" Garbage Bags and take them out to a Garbage Collection Location

Oversized

Large Items that do not fit into Designated Garbage Bags (45L)

Bringing Oversized Garbage to the Daio Cleaning Center (Environment and Garbage Countermeasure Section) and the Ago Cleaning Center

● You cannot bring any garbage other than Oversized Garbage

● Outside of the times listed to the right, please bring your Oversized Garbage to the Yamada Eco-Center.

Household Pickups for Oversized Garbage (Fee Charged) require reservations beforehand. Environment Garbage Countermeasure Section 0599-72-3718

Items That Will NOT Be Collected

Air Conditioners, TVs, Refrigerators, Freezers, Washing Machines, Dryers

Please make a request with a purchasing store (second-hand shop) or the store you bought/exchanged the item from to have it collected.

Motorized Bicycle, Motorcycle (Recyclable) Fire Extinguisher (Recyclable) Computer (Schedule Collection via renet.jp) Other Items (Non-Disposable Items) Dehumidifiers, Smoke Canisters, Gas Cylinders, Construction Waste, Tires, Waste Oil, Batteries, Toxic Materials (e.g. Pesticides, etc.), Fishing Nets, Industrial Waste, Vehicle Parts, and Other Non-Disposable Items.

Please make a request with a purchasing store (second-hand shop), the store you bought the item from or a waste service company to dispose of the item.

Bringing Garbage to the Yamada Eco-Center

Fee Charged

● Please do not bring garbage in bags that prevent their contents from being confirmed, such as Black Garbage Bags

● A fee will still be charged even if you bring your garbage in City-Designated Garbage Bags
